Dear Parents/Carers,

We are now in a position to provide details about how the 2020 GCSE Exam Results day will run. As I am sure you will appreciate, the day will have to run a little differently this year due to the social distancing rules that are in place.

We will be releasing the results for GCSE examinations on **Thursday 20th August at 9:00 am.**

Students with surnames beginning with letters A to L will enter the school site from our West Gate entrance (closest to Waitrose). Students with surnames beginning with letters M to Z will enter the school site from our East Gate entrance.

Results will be issued from the main school hall. Students can gain access to the hall via the entrances along the front of the building, by the table tennis tables.

Due to social distancing guidance in place for schools we are unable to accommodate parents/carers within the main school building while students are collecting results. If parents/carers wish to accompany their child to collect the results, we politely request that they wait on the main school playground or by the bike sheds to support social distancing.

Exam board rules stipulate that results are only able to be issued directly to students, and for this reason we are unable to release results to any third party, including parents/carers.

Enrolment into our Sixth Form will take place with our Sixth Form team the same day in the cafeteria.

Now that you have officially finished year 11 if you have any ties, blazers or PE kit in good condition that you are willing to donate, please bring this with you and hand in to the main school office.
