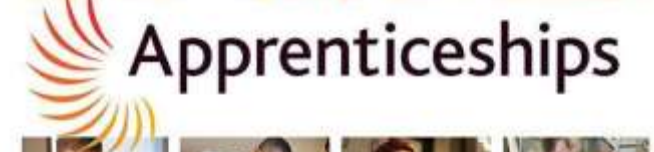

Salary

Starting around £15k rising to £27k+ with experience.

Many banks have profit related bonus schemes as well as subsidised mortgages, loans and pensions.

What does a Bank Cashier do?

Bank Cashiers are the first point of contact for anyone coming into a bank which makes the role very customer focused and sales based. The basic duties would include cashing cheques, checking statements, processing payments, making money transfers, updating accounts and generally helping customers with their queries.

Typically the hours would be 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday however, you may require you to work Saturday's as more and more branches now open at weekend's.

Banks usually like to promote within it's company so there would be good opportunities to advance up the career ladder.

The required qualifications are a minimum of four GCSE grades 9 to 4 (A-C) including maths and English.

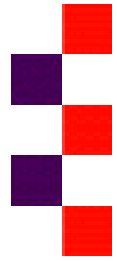
